Main Thought: Jesus Christ is God and the Creator of the Universe.

Introduction

• Ancient Hymn

Jesus Christ's relation to God.

- Col: 1:15 "The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation."
- Jesus Is The Image of God | v15
 - John 1:1, 9-12, 14-18; Rom 1:20; 1 Tim 5:16; Heb 3:1-3; Col 2:3,9
 - Exact representation.
- The Firstborn of All Creation | v15
 - "Firstborn" denotes two things of Christ: He preceded the whole Creation, and He is Sovereign over all Creation. – Supreme One.

The Rescue From The Dominion Of Darkness | v12b-14

- Col 1:16 "For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him."
- Jesus is the Creator of all Things | v. 16
 - \circ Things in heaven invisible.
 - \circ Things on Earth Visible.
 - o Thrones, powers, rulers, or authorities.
 - All things created through him and for him.
 - Hebrews 1:6-8 v. 6 Let all God's angels worship Him.
 - Romans 1:21-23 Sin moves us to worship the creation rather than the Creator God.
- Col 1:17 "He is before all things, and in him, all things hold together."
- Jesus Eternally Existed | v.17

- "No creature is autonomous. All are God's servants (Ps 119:91) and dependents (Ps. 104)" (Wright 1987:73).
- Jesus Sustains all Things | v17b
 - Hebrews 1:3 Jesus Christ upholds all things by the word of His power.
 - If the Lord sustains and holds all things together in the universe; can he hold things together for you?

What is your Hymn of Response - Jesus Christ is God and the Creator of the Universe.

Questions for Personal and Group Discussion

- 1. What is your favorite Worship Hymn or Song? Why?
- 2. How does the teaching of Jesus Christ, the Image of God, impact your view of Jesus Christ?
- 3. Discuss the phrase "Firstborn of all Creation." What shows that it is about position (Supreme One) rather than birth order or being created?
- 4. What does it mean that Jesus is the Creator of all things? How vast is the creative power of Christ?
- 5. Today people worship angels and spirit guides. What argument do Paul and the writer of Hebrews give to show that "Angel Worship" is false worship?
- 6. In Romans I we see the destructive process of sin and judgment when we do not worship the Creator Redeeming God. How do you see this downward sinful progression in our culture?
- 7. How does Paul show in this passage that everything Jesus Christ has created are "servants and dependents" on him?
- 8. Jesus Christ is the sustainer and holds all things together by His word. Why does this truth about Jesus impact our daily lives as a follower of Christ?
- 9. Take time to memorize this passage or write your own Hymn in praise that Jesus Christ is God and the Creator of the Universe.
