#### **The Problem**

We have all been deceived, confused, or detoured by false teachings and a religious spirit.

#### **Main Thought:**

Spiritual fullness means complete salvation, full forgiveness, and absolute victory in Jesus Christ.

## 1. Complete Salvation Is By Jesus Christ | 2:11

- No religious ritual can make us alive in Jesus Christ.
- The Bible is clear even in the Old Testament (Deut. 10:16; 30:6) that physical circumcision saves no one.
- N.T. Rom. 2:28–29; Gal 6:12-15; Rom 4:7-15

## 2. Alive With Jesus Christ | 2:12-14

- Jesus is our crucified conqueror, and we are forgiven by him.
- The baptism Paul is talking about (v. 12) is the spiritual baptism, where we are united and identified with Christ in his death, burial, and resurrection (Rom. 6:1–7)

### 3. Absolute Victory in Jesus Christ | 2:13-15

- Overcome opposition.
- By fulfilling the demands of the Law, Christ disarmed the demonic powers and authorities (cf. 1:16; 2:10), triumphing over them. As a result, believers are delivered from these evil powers, which inspire legalistic rules...<sup>1</sup>

## **Main Take Away:**

Drop/Cut Off the thing you trust to give you fullness without Jesus Christ.
